The scholarship will cover a Master's/MPhil degree at an HEC-recognised Pakistani public or private university in one of the following subject areas only:

- Education
- Sustainable Energy
- Food Security and Agriculture
- · Health Sciences
- STEM Education


#### **Eligibility Criteria**
